Also, on September 2, 2019, the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 562 "On guarantees of equal rights and opportunities for women and men" was adopted in Uzbekistan. The Chairman of the Senate of the Oliy Majlis, Tanzila Narbaeva, is the Chairman of the Commission on Gender Equality of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
